



Early Malaga Schools

A schoolhouse built in 1788 in Malaga is mentioned in the book Under Four Flags.

Also noted is Starling Bridge School, built about 1790 in Franklinville.

Both schools predate the 1820 creation of the Township of Franklin.

A school on Route 40 from 1872 until early 1900's was purchased as a retail store until its 1971 demolition.
